Problem Behavior Definitions - Minor Incident

- **Defiance** - Brief or low intensity failure to respond to an adult request.
- **Disrespectful Communication** - Verbal, written or gestural put downs. (Excluding vulgarity)
- **Unprepared for Instruction** - Chronically does not have materials (homework or assignment book) required for lessons or activity. (Consider age, time of year and circumstantial situations for students)
- **Dishonesty** -
 - a) Lying - Student delivers a message that is untrue.
 - b) Cheating - Violating standards of academic honesty.
- **Property Misuse** - Inappropriate use or damage to school or personal property that does not render the object permanently unusable.
- **Physical Contact** - Non serious but inappropriate contact.

Problem Behavior Definitions - Major Incident

- **Abusive Communication** - Verbal, written or gestural language that includes vulgar or abusive name calling.
- **Fight/Physical Aggression** - Actions that involve physical contact where injury could occur. (Includes: hitting, kicking, pushing, spitting and biting)
- **Overt Defiance** - Sustained or high intensity failure to respond to adult request.
- **Harassment/Teasing/Bullying** - Disrespectful behavior or communication that threatens or intimidates.
- **Disruption** - Behavior that results in sustained or significant interruption of the school or classroom activity.
- **Stealing** - Claiming someone else's property as your own.
- **Vandalism** - Student participates in an activity that results in substantial destruction or permanent disfigurement of personal or school property.
- **Dishonesty** -
 - a) Lying - Student delivers a message that is untrue.
 - b) Cheating - Violating standards of academic honesty.
