After-School Classes to Start for Portfolio & Capstone

Seniors urged to attend in order to complete PBGR graduation requirements

Coventry High is again offering after school “ramp-up” classes so that seniors can complete their proficiency-based graduation requirements. Scoring and judging is included in the programs.

PORTFOLIO Ramp-Up and Scoring:

Starting **Monday, March 1**, there will be a Ramp Up class for seniors who did not submit a Graduation Portfolio and who need to complete tasks. It will run every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday (except the last class, March 25 – class will meet on Friday the 26th). The fee is \$50 for any and all sessions. **ALL Graduation Portfolios MUST be submitted by MARCH 31**

CAPSTONE Ramp-Up and Judging:

For seniors who have not completed their Capstone project, they may attend the Capstone Ramp-up classes which begin on **March 29**.

Classes meet every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, through April 15.

Seniors will present their Capstones to a panel on the afternoon of **MAY 12**.

Any senior not finished with either requirement after these Ramp Up sessions will NOT graduate in June 2010, and will be required to finish these key components in summer school.
